Health Surveillance

Ruttle Plant are now members of the Constructing Better Health (CBH) Scheme whereby our employees undergo a full health screening to meet CBH standards. This comes in the form of screening and regular medical and wellbeing questionnaires. This information is compiled and stored on a database and the operator holds a CBH medical card which holds the necessary information indicating they are fit for work. Operators will be able to present this card on site upon request.
